Why Education Perfect (EP)

We were initially intrigued that there could be a way for students to learn vocabulary using a device. At the time we were moving towards BYOD and saw LP (as it was known then) as a way to streamline vocabulary learning. It was also a lot more fun than staring at a list in a vocabulary notebook and not really knowing how to learn it (despite teachers' best efforts).

We have a lot of Year 9 language classes as it was compulsory to learn one of the 4 languages that we offer in Year 9; sometimes as many as 16 classes. Many of the students were not intending to continue into Year 10. Because they had not mastered the vocabulary needed to progress through the various topics, they often became switched off during Term 3 and had trouble keeping up with the lessons. Since having EP we have noticed that this happens much less, with most students able to retain the vocabulary they need due to their homework tasks on EP. Therefore they can participate positively in the lessons.

EP fits perfectly with our school's digital strategic goal.

Impact

The positive impacts of EP for our department include the following:

- EP has definitely helped with the learning of vocabulary - students results are better now.
- Differentiation is possible so that students can pace themselves. Low ability/disengaged students are working well on EP and coping with more complex material
- it's easy to keep students on task in class by tracking their progress, and there is less time needed for marking when they have completed their lessons.
- EP has solved homework problems for us - there are no page numbers, or books involved. Students simply get an email with their work linked - it's easy for everyone.
