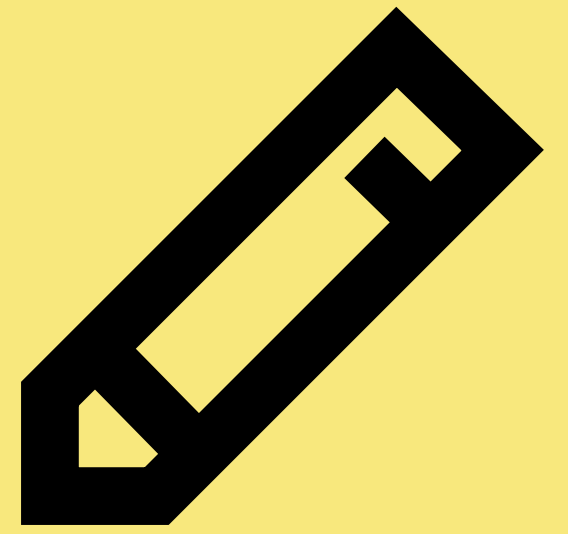


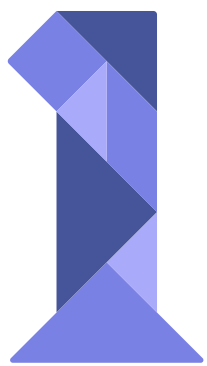
# Writing strategies



Before writing

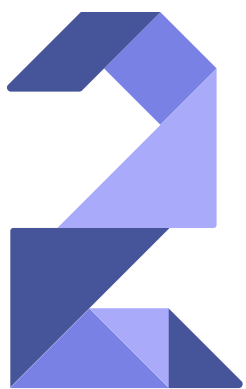

## Targeted writing

## Use prior knowledge

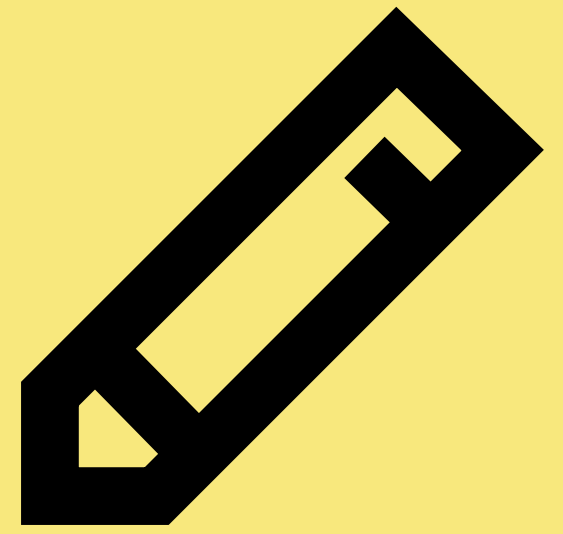
I make connections between the subject, text genre and my thoughts. I use information from several sources in my writing.

I make a structured plan for my writing. I know I might make mistakes, but need to deliver my message all the same.

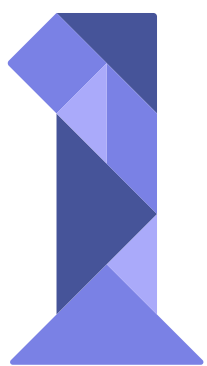

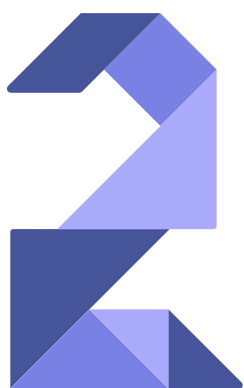

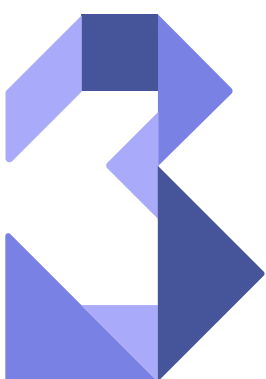
## Draft the text

I think about the text type and content. I use available resources like dictionaries, and I include words and expressions relevant to the topic.



## Make revisions

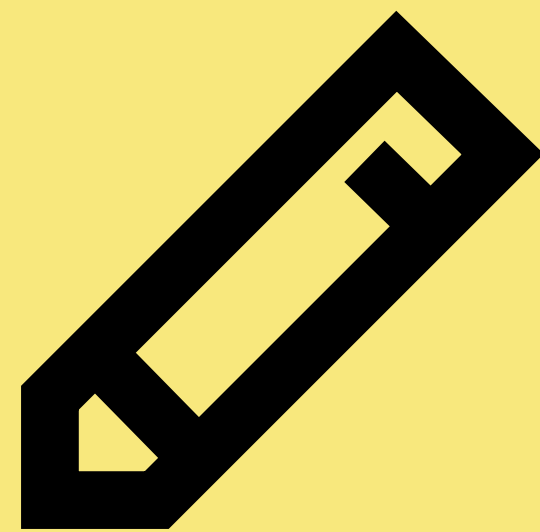
I check my word use, fluidity, and phrasing. I think about the organisation of my text and supporting elements if needed. I check my spelling, grammar and punctuation.



## Final copy

I prepare a final version of my text after thinking about the final layout and making any corrections.

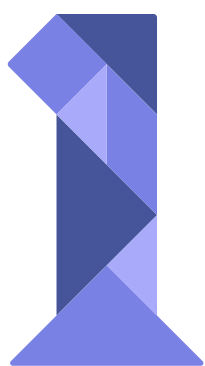

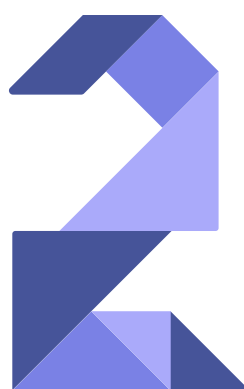
