

# Educator Insights Reveal the Value of Education Perfect

The impact on teaching and learning across instruction,  
practice and assessment.

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# Introduction

At Education Perfect (EP), everything we do is underpinned by evidence. The EP Learning Cycle and Mastery Model underpin our pedagogical approach and platform behaviour, and are based on decades of education research.

However, there is another form of evidence that lies at the core of what we do — the judgement, recommendations, and feedback of teachers who interact daily with EP. Their stories from the classroom give us insight into how they use EP, how it has contributed to their practice, and how it has benefitted their students' learning.

The information provided here is a snapshot of what teachers from a range of countries have told us about their use of EP over the last three years. Their comments were offered voluntarily, through an open invitation on EP's website to share their stories with us. Over 1,000 responses were collected from January 2023 to March 2026.

“I’ve found Education Perfect to be an invaluable resource for both my students and myself. # Methodology

Educate Ventures Research analysed the responses using a mixed human–AI workflow that combined AI-driven vector clustering with structured human oversight to ensure both scale and interpretability. The process employed inductive and deductive logic, mapping testimonials to specific value pillars while using diagnostics and manual reviews to maintain data auditability. Ultimately, this iterative approach triangulated AI groupings with human expertise to ensure the findings were grounded in the data, generated by a human-led, AI-aided process, and formulated through multiple rounds of group analysis and reflection among the research team.

## Respondents

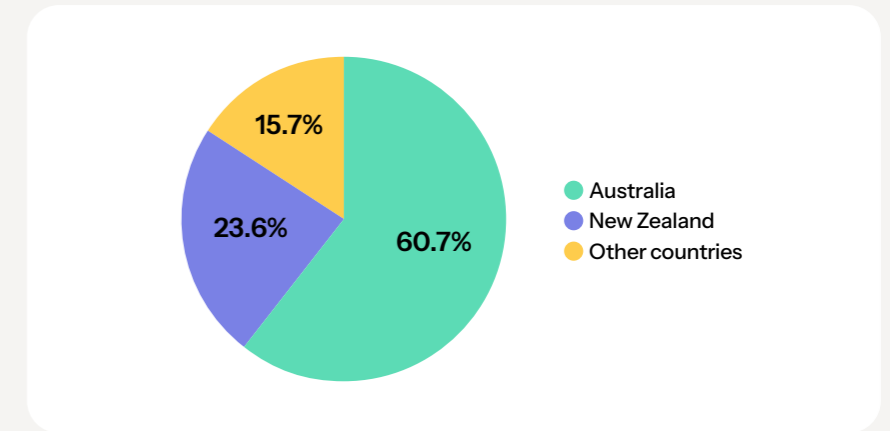


Fig. 1 distribution of responses by country

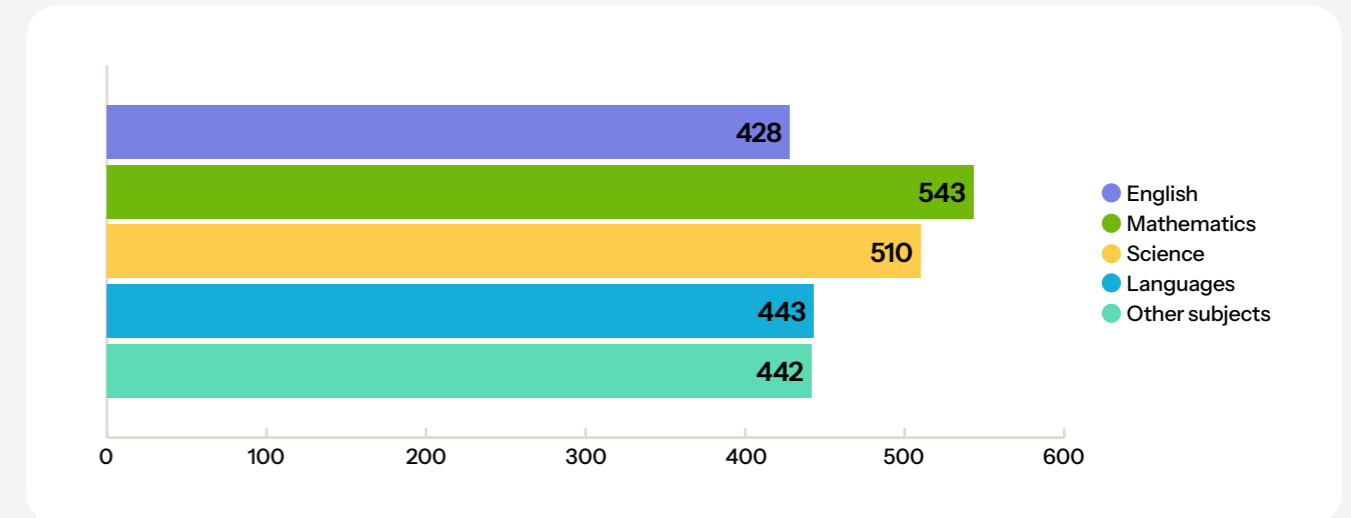


Fig. 2 counts of testimonials by subject

The testimonials are predominantly from Australia and New Zealand (Figure 1) and span a broad range of subjects (Figure 2), with English, Mathematics, Science and Languages most strongly represented, indicating how extensively EP is used across multiple subject areas.

# EP's Four Value Pillars

EP's platform is built on a deliberate set of choices informed by research which shows that teaching and learning are enhanced when:

- Student motivation and metacognitive awareness are improved;
- Teachers are supported to differentiate and personalise learning for every student;
- Immediate, actionable feedback is provided to students, and;
- Teachers have access to insights about student progress and learning progress is visible to students, teachers, and school leaders alike.

The breadth of the testimonials confirms the benefit teachers gain from EP's support across all four of these value pillars, with a particularly high number of testimonials relating to differentiation & personalisation.



## Motivation and Metacognition

Research shows that students with stronger metacognition tend to be more motivated and engaged in learning. EP supports the connection between metacognition and motivation by providing clear success criteria, scaffolded progression, actionable feedback and ongoing visibility of learning progress. When students can track their progress and understand where they are in their learning journey, they are empowered to take ownership of their learning, which in turn stimulates motivation (McCombs, 2015).

# Differentiation and Personalisation

While both are essential in any classroom, differentiation focuses on the teacher’s ability to adjust instruction to meet a broad range of student abilities and attainment levels, whereas personalisation aims to make learning more effective by ensuring that each student is working in their Zone of Proximal Development, where things are neither too easy nor too difficult (Vygotsky, 1978). Both can be time-consuming and complicated for teachers. EP is able to alleviate the burden with targeted instruction, customisable learning materials and assessment, tailored assignment of lesson sections for targeted skill practice, and automatically generated next step recommendations which ensure unique learning pathways for every student.

# Visibility of Progress

Data collection and analysis is an essential component of strategic planning in today’s schools but keeping track of individual student progress can be an overwhelming challenge for teachers and school leaders. EP’s continuous tracking of student learning through each phase of the learning cycle (instruction, practice and assessment) supports robust teacher estimates of achievement. By providing a real-time, multi-level view of student progress across individuals, classes and cohorts, progress is visible not just to teachers but to school leaders. For students, that same visibility is evidence of their own learning growth and an important tool for learner autonomy.
