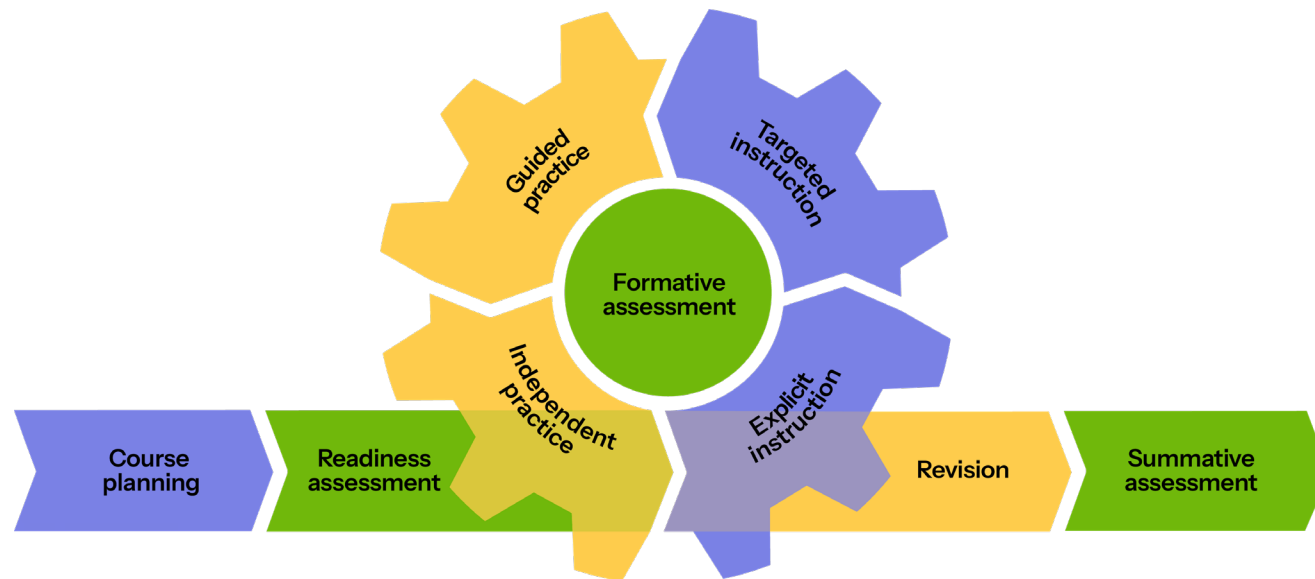


Education Perfect Learning Cycle

Instruction

Course planning: align to existing scope and sequence; customise or create lessons and assessments.

Explicit instruction: success criteria, direct explanations and modelling; scaffolded progression.

Targeted instruction: understand student learning progress; tailor activities to small groups or individuals.

Practice and Revision

Guided practice: checks for understanding; formative feedback; gradual release of responsibility.

Independent practice: questions build in cognitive demand; mastery progression; built-in spaced retrieval.

Revision: teacher-assigned review activities; student-led consolidation of previous learning.

Assessment

Readiness assessment: premade readiness assessments; on-the-fly quizzes; actionable next steps.

Formative assessment: embedded formative checks; ongoing feedback to students and insights to teachers.

Summative assessment: premade and customisable curriculum-aligned assessments and reporting.

Instruction, practice and revision, and assessment are deeply intertwined to create a cohesive learning ecosystem. The powerful connections between each phase are what makes the EP Learning Cycle so effective. Instruction becomes more targeted because it's informed by readiness and formative assessment. Practice becomes more deliberate because it's guided by instructional feedback. Assessment becomes a tool for growth, providing actionable insights to continuously refine teaching and learning.

The EP Learning Cycle is a flexible, translatable framework rather than a prescriptive model. Schools can engage with it in a way that best supports their own instructional approach. Whatever combination of use cases a teacher engages with, each phase guides students with feedback and informs teachers with insights — with progress visible to students, teachers and leaders at every step.
